Why „Evidence-based medicine”?

- Evidence-based practice has become, during the last years, the dominant force of the health care.
- Basically, health care based on evidence represents the most critical analysis of the current research, placement of the information in a specific clinical context and the addition of the clinicians and patients perspectives. In other words, evidence-based medicine represents the consciously, explicitly and judicious utilisation of the best evidence when decisions related to the individual care of the patients are made.

What is evidence-based medicine?

- a careful examination of the finalised research studies
- complete revision of the recommendation process
- critical analysis of the integrated research within organizational context and taking into account the practical perspectives of the patients and clinicians

What is not evidence-based medicine?

- research project
- simple support of the national practices (like, for example, guidelines)
- review with bibliography or research articles for different interventions or health policies

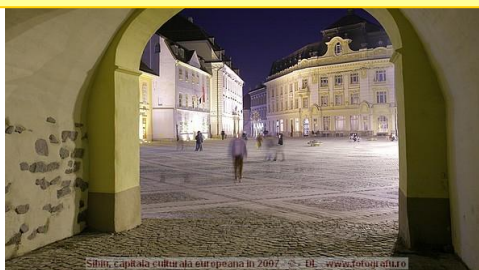
